Terms and Conditions

By participating, you agree that:

ELIGIBILITY: You must be 18 years or older to purchase a raffle entry. Purchasers of raffle tickets must be a US resident physically residing in the United States and not be precluded from participating by any governmental law or regulation. RAFFLE TICKET PURCHASES: EHS and its agents, volunteers, partners, students, and employees assume no liability for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, illegible, or undelivered entries. Entries received without proper payment will be deemed invalid and shall be disqualified immediately. All purchases of tickets are non-refundable (except at the discretion of EHS in the event of ineligibility).

Tickets may be purchased:

- (i) in person at Elder High School during regular business hours until 3:00 PM on Monday, March 22, 2021
- (ii) in person from person-to-person sales from EHS volunteers, students, or representatives until the Draw Date,
- (iv) by telephone by dialing (513)921-3401 during the hours of 9:00 AM until 3:00 PM (ET), Monday through Friday by speaking with a EHS representative until Monday, March 22, 2021, (note that no tickets may be purchased by voicemail message).
- (v) for Ohio residents only, via internet purchase at www.elderhs.org/Boosters until 3:00 PM on Monday, March 22, 2021.

Entrants who purchase ticket entries using options (iv) or (v) must provide a valid email address since entry confirmation numbers will be sent via email. When an order is placed using options (iv) or (v), an authorized representative from EHS will complete the ticket entry by filling in the name, address, and phone number provided and will enter the raffle ticket in the drawing. Checks should be made payable to Elder High School. Credit cards accepted are Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express.

[Please Note: The mailing and email addresses provided during the ticket purchase shall be considered as the addresses for all future correspondence between EHS and the entrant. If either of these addresses changes it is the entrant's responsibility to inform EHS of such change, via the Raffle Administrator, see above].

RAFFLE TICKET PRICES: Ticket prices are 1 ticket for \$5 each or 5 tickets for \$20.

DRAWINGS: The Draw Date is Friday, March 26, 2021 beginning at approximately 12:00 PM (ET) at 3900 Vincent Avenue in Cincinnati, Ohio. Ticket sales shall cease at that time. In this raffle, one ticket will be selected by a representative of EHS in accordance with Ohio law and these Terms. The first ticket selected that meets the requirements as set forth in these Terms ("Winning Ticket") will win the prize. The prize will be awarded to the individual whose name appears on the Winning Ticket. If the name of more than one person is submitted on the Winning Ticket, then the first name listed shall be deemed the Winner. If the ticket contains incomplete information, or the ticket is otherwise deemed to be void, then another ticket will be drawn.

PRIZE: The prize shall be fifty percent (50% of the value of the tickets properly purchased in accordance with these Terms. The value of the prize will depend on the number of tickets sold.

NOTIFICATION OF WINNER: Winner need not be present to win. Winner will be notified by phone and by email required procedures to claim the prize. Winners name will be posted at http://elderhs.org within two (2) business days after the Draw Date. Winner may have up to ten (10) business days of the Draw Date to finalize the process of acquiring the prize. Winners name and location by city or town and photo may be printed in select media and at http://elderhs.org and in news releases and other publicity for and from EHS. If the winner is unable to be contacted or located after a period of ninety (90) days from the Draw Date, the prize will be donated to EHS. Three (3) attempts will be made to contact the winning entry via phone, email, and registered mail at the contact information provided by the entry purchaser. To claim a prize, a ticket stub or emailed confirmation number together with a photo ID will be required. An affidavit of eligibility may be required from prize winner.
